Luke 24:1-9

But very early on Sunday morning the women went to the tomb, taking the spices they had prepared. <sup>2</sup>They found that the stone had been rolled away from the entrance. <sup>3</sup>So they went in, but they didn’t find the body of the Lord Jesus. <sup>4</sup>As they stood there puzzled, two men suddenly appeared to them, clothed in dazzling robes. <sup>5</sup>The women were terrified and bowed with their faces to the ground. Then the men asked, “Why are you looking among the dead for someone who is alive? <sup>6</sup>He isn’t here! He is risen from the dead! Remember what he told you back in Galilee, <sup>7</sup>that the Son of Man must be betrayed into the hands of sinful men and be crucified, and that he would rise again on the third day.” <sup>8</sup>Then they remembered that he had said this. <sup>9</sup>So they rushed back from the tomb to tell his eleven disciples—and everyone else—what had happened.
